<p>Referrals must be made through an appropriate support organisation. A thorough risk assessment should be carried out to ensure survivors have independent living skills and sufficient emotional stability to manage on their own overnight at college. We encourage key workers to get in touch so we can arrange to meet students in advance of making an application.</p> <p>Participants in this programme have varying levels of ability to speak English. At a minimum we would expect students to be able to hold a basic one to one conversation in English. The course work is highly differentiated and written work is kept to a minimum, unless students wish to improve grammar and spelling in which case more advanced work will be set for them.</p>	<p>The course lasts for ten weeks but many students have progressed from Free Thinking into the college's mainstream education programme and we maintain regular contact with students as much as possible.</p>	<p>The college is based just outside Barnsley but the residential aspect makes it accessible from anywhere in the country since the first day's teaching does not start until midday</p>	<p>There is a maximum of 15 students on each course. Childcare for under 5 year old is also available</p>	<p>Free Thinking is a residential programme of education designed to help survivors build confidence, resilience and skills to live, work and study in the UK. The course runs biannually in Summer and Autumn. Students attend for three days/two nights each week (15 hours) for ten week and stay overnight at Northern College campus at Wentworth Castle. All accommodation is single occupancy with en-suite bathroom. The curriculum is highly varied and includes teambuilding, communication skills, storytelling and drama, outdoor classroom, navigation, first aid, film making, employment rights and responsibilities, history, geography and culture of the UK, IT skills plus optional ESOL classes. The programme is constantly under review and student feedback has played a large part in deciding how to structure the course.</p> <p>One of the key ingredients of our success is the exceptional quality of Additional Learning and Pastoral Support that we are able to offer to learners, who often have very low levels of personal confidence and self-esteem.</p> <p>We also have a children's centre on site. During the week we can cater for children from 6 months up to the age of 5 and at weekends to the age of 11. However spaces are limited.</p> <p>Many students on this programme are supported by organisations that hold a government NRM contract. This means the referral organisation still retains their legal duty of care over students while they are resident at Northern College. In certain circumstances it will be necessary to share information, particularly for students who are still within the NRM and living in safe houses. However, unless there is a potential safeguarding issue we would not share information without written student consent. We are happy to discuss this further and formalise any data sharing protocols between our organisations.</p>
