Seeking to address: Single Incident Trauma (Type 1), Multiple Traumas (Type 2) and multiple pervasive traumas from an early age that continue over length of time (Type 3). Our specialism is complex trauma (Type 3). Trauma experiences may include: bullying, bereavement, abuse, domestic abuse, child sexual exploitation, trafficking, early life trauma, refugee, family mental health problems. The Trauma Recovery Centre has Designated Safeguarding Lead and Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead, both of whom are familiar with local authority procedures in making referrals for additional support. Every staff member			

	working with families are familiar with Child Protection Policy and Procedures and has attended safeguarding training.
	At the TRC, we work with charities and organisations that support children who have faced extreme trauma, including some anti-trafficking organisations. Our Training Centre in Bath has many aspects, all aimed at helping to develop a better understanding of the issues children are facing, and to provide excellent training to the professionals who work with children, young people and families. We do offer training in other cities and this can be arranged via email.
