Direct Work ICTGs

Our direct work ICTG's have been helping young people to get online safely either using their own devices or supported by foster carers and residential staff and using a range of different platforms.

Now that we are set up online ICTG's have been able to continue with one to one sessions which means they can respond to the needs of individual young people and continue to build consistent relationships and offer support

We are also keeping in touch with young people by post, finding and creating resources tailored to meet young people's needs.

We have created a pack for any young person referred to the service during this period; the pack includes small items to welcome them and a letter translated into the appropriate language which introduces the service and the ICTG role.


ICTG Regional Practice Coordinators
